

Our annual Walk would NOT happen without the dedication and time shared by each of our amazing local Walk Coordinators and a host of local volunteers! If you have an interest in helping plan your local walk or are limited to volunteering on walk day only, there is a job for you and we welcome you as a volunteer. 2023 Walk Locations: Carroll, Cedar Rapids, Dubuque, Fort Dodge, Le Mars, Urbandale (*NEW central location) and Washington.

How can my employer or Business be a sponsor?

How do I register for the Walk?


There are three ways for you to register for your local Walk.
