

A Review of September

Did you know that the month of September is Infant Mortality Awareness Month, Baby Safety Month, and NICU Awareness Month? September kept the Foundation busy with outreach, education and advocating for these special topics each of which tie into safe sleep and SIDS awareness.

The Infant mortality rate, an important marker of the overall health of a society was 5.6 in 2022 which was the first rise in 20 years. The five leading causes of infant mortality include birth defects, preterm birth and low birth weight, SIDS, Injuries like suffocation, and maternal pregnancy complications. The Iowa SIDS Foundation participated in the Roll Baby Roll infant mortality awareness event sponsored by EveryStep on Thursday September 26th. At this event Foundation representative were able to provide families with safe sleep education, pacifiers, and safe sleep board books.

Baby Safety Month is also a great time to remind caregivers about the importance of safety during sleep! And safe sleep pertains to even the smallest of infants and those with special healthcare needs like NICU babies. There is a higher SUID risk among preterm and low birth weight infants and the American Academy of Pediatrics urgers medical providers in the NICU setting to educate and model safe sleep to families in the hospital setting to help them successfully and safely transition home.

Federal Grant to Support Community Outreach and Education in 2025



The Iowa SIDS Foundation is looking forward to further partnership with Iowa Health in Human Services in 2025 to improve education and outreach on safe sleep.

With federal grant funding to the Iowa SIDS Foundation and Iowa HHS, improvements will be made to have safe sleep uniform messaging and shared materials, increase safe sleep public

awareness and understanding, enhance safe sleep education for medical students and health care professionals, and provide tangible safe sleep items such as pack n plays and pacifiers to the general public.

The Foundation plans to specifically update current educational posters, and add new educational material. The Foundation will work closely with designated HHS staff to help meet these program objectives. With a rise in lowa SUID, we are hopeful these improvements will help save babies lives in the years to come.
