On June 27, 1994, Dawn and Kevin Maughan lost their son Joseph to Sudden Infant Death Syndrome. Shortly following his death, Dawn asked artist P. Buckley Moss to create a print in dedication to babies who have died unexpectedly due to SIDS. P. Buckley Moss graciously fulfilled Dawn's request and created a painting entitled, "Heavenly Babe."



Walk for the Future 2022 to be held on Saturday, August 27th

Your local volunteers and Foundation staff are working on plans for the 23rd annual Walk for the Future! This event is intended for family, friends, and our local communities to come together to honor and remember babies that have died tragically too soon, while raising awareness for SIDS and safe sleep. 2021 was a recording breaking year and we are excited for 2022! Whether you have joined us at the Walk every year, if you have only been able to attend sporadically, or this is your first year, we hope you plan on joining us on August 27, 2022 at one of the seven planned locations. Information regarding each of the locations is continuously updated on our website, www.iowasids.org, as it is received from our amazing Walk Coordinators. Where are the Walks in 2022?

Carroll, Cedar Rapids, Dubuque, Fort Dodge, Grimes, Le Mars and Washington.

How can my employer or Business be a sponsor?

We love to welcome new and returning sponsors and offer three levels of sponsorship: Bronze starting at \$250, \$500 Silver, and Gold being \$1000 or more. Sponsors are critical in helping defray the operating costs of the seven statewide walks, which allows the funds raised by volunteers and families to be maximized for bereavement resources, safe sleep education, and to support research! All sponsors must be confirmed no later than June 17, 2022.

How can I add my baby's name to the back of the shirt?

If you are interested in including your baby's name on the back of the 2022 Walk shirts, a consent signed by one of baby's PARENTS is required to be on file at our main office. If you completed a consent in the past it does **not** need to be renewed yearly unless you preferences have changed.

If you are not sure if your baby has a consent on file or if you need a consent form, call our office and we will be happy to help. Please note that the waiver found on the registration form that you are required to sign is for liability; this does NOT give us permission to include your baby on the shirts. All consents must be received no later than July 29, 2022 for your baby to be included on the 2022 shirts.

How do I register for the Walk?

There are three ways for you to register for your local Walk.

- On line registration will be available at www.iowasids.org beginning June 1,2022.
- 2. Paper registrations will be mailed to addresses in our
- 3. database the beginning of July.
- Registration will be available on-site the morning of the Walk. However, we can not guarantee a walk shirt will be available. To save money and guarantee you receive a shirt in your preferred size, pre-registration on or before 8/5/22 is requested.

What does it cost?

On or before 8/5/22: \$25 for adults and \$10 for youth. On or after 8/6/22: \$30 for adults and \$15 for youth.

Does the Walk need volunteers?

ABSOLUTELY!! Our annual Walk would NOT happen without the dedication and time shared by each of our amazing local Walk Coordinators and a host of local volunteers!

Volunteers are needed for ALL Walk locations. If you have an interest in helping plan your local walk or are limited to volunteering on walk day only, there is a job for you and we welcome you as a volunteer. Please contact the office to be connected with your local Walk Coordinator.

What happens if it's raining or storming on Walk day?

In the event that Walk Day has inclement weather, delays for individual sites will be posted on our Facebook page and on our website. If it appears to be an all day weather event and it is unsafe to walk, the event would be cancelled with no refunds.
